This is our 8th performance of the Nutcracker and will be performed every other year. Our goal is to start a holiday tradition that will offer your child the opportunity to perform in a production you will be proud to share with family and friends. <u>This performance is optional</u>. All students enrolled in ballet at BPA (either ballet combo or full ballet classes) are eligible to participate (**this does not include creative movement**).

- 1. REHEARSALS: Rehearsals for some dances will take place the last 10 minutes of class time and on extra practices as per the enclosed schedule. All dancers will be expected to be at ALL rehearsals. If there is a scheduling conflict, please let me know as soon as you receive this packet. All dancers appear on stage in the finale and this is "set" at the theatre only during dress rehearsal.
- 2. NUTCRACKER PERFORMANCE DONATION: We ask every dancer in "The Nutcracker" to make a \$30.00 performance donation. This helps offset the cost of costume construction, cleaning, repairs, storage, etc. The costumes remain the property of Backstage Performing Arts. The costumes will be taken to the theatre and your dancer will put them on and take them off and leave them at the theatre. You will need to provide proper tights, shoes and undergarments for your dancer. Please send your Nutcracker performance donation by <u>AUG. 29th.</u> You will receive (1) ticket to one performance (per performance donation). Anyone taking up a seat in the Auditorium will need to purchase a ticket.
- 3. TICKETS: Tickets will be sold for the performance. Prices are \$10 for adults and children 3 years and over. Children under 3 years of age are free but must sit and an adult's lap.
- 4. NUTCRACKER SHIRTS: Our 2024 Nutcracker design and order form are at the front desk and will be available on navy long sleeve. Price is \$22.
- 5. VOLUNTEERS: We need every family to volunteer in some way. Please get the dressing room Mom slots filled as quickly as possible. Any classes who do not have dressing room help will not be able to perform! Sign--up at the front desk when the volunteer book becomes available!
- 6. ALL dancers, except Little Angels, will have to wear a nude leotard under their costumes. These are \$15-\$20 and may be purchased in the boutique.
- 7. ALL DANCERS AGE 9 AND OVER, MUST WEAR DEODORANT !!
- 8. <u>Make-up</u> Stage makeup similar to what we wear at recital must be worn.

We are hopeful that this schedule will give us ample rehearsal time. If we see that more time is needed, we will have to schedule more practice times! Keep an eye open for revisions! All dancers are expected at all rehearsals. You MUST let Mrs. Melvie know if you have a conflict with any scheduled practice time.

THEATRE RULES for DANCERS

1. No dancers are ever allowed in the audience or lobby during a performance. You should not be seen in your costume before your entrance on stage.

2. Pink ballet shoes need to be clean and have elastic sewn on, no strings showing -- tuck them in.

3. Pink ballet tights (purchased at the studio) need to be clean with no holes. NO UNDERWEAR UNDER YOUR TIGHTS! You will be wearing a nude leotard under your costume (everyone except little angels)

4. Hair should be slicked back into a classical bun. Bangs need to be slicked back off the face. No wispies. Use hair gel, hair spray, and/or put the hair up slightly wet. No shiny clips, glitter or barrettes - just lots of bobby pins! Use a fine hair net the color of your own hair to keep your bun tidy. You can find those at the drugstore.

5. NO EATING OR DRINKING IN COSTUME! Only water. No food or drink backstage!

6. NO JEWELRY, NAIL POLISH, WATCHES, RINGS OR EARRINGS. A uniform, clean look is our goal!

- 7. Dancers need to be quiet backstage & listen to dressing room Moms.
- 8. Young dancers could bring a book, quiet toy, game or something to do while they wait backstage.

9. NO COSTUMES ARE ALLOWED ON THE FLOOR! Please hang them on YOUR hanger when you take them off. Be sure to return all parts and props to their places, i.e. swords, harps, arm bands, etc.

10. QUIET BACKSTAGE, PLEASE!!!

11. Smile & enjoy presenting your talents and love of dance to the audience!!
